Tournament Rules

1. Entry is open to members of the Iowa 600 Bowling Club whose dues are paid PRIOR to participating. **All participants must be current members of the USBC and the Iowa State USBC WBA.**
2. Rules 319a-2 (10-pin average), 319d (prize winnings provisions), and 319e (tournament average) are waived. Incorrect averages will be governed by Rule 319a-3. All other USBC rules and regulations shall remain in effect. ***Disclaimer: USBC language/rules will apply in all areas affected.***
3. Entrants shall use their highest USBC certified league average, as a regular or a substitute bowler, in the following order: (a) book or ending 2009-2010 winter season average, 21 games or more; (b) ending 2010 summer season average, 21 games or more; (c) January 1, 2010, average, 21 games or more; (d) 12 games or more as of the date of her participation in the tournament. Bowlers who do not meet any of the above requirements will be entered with a 240 average.
4. The penalty for submitting an incorrect average is as follows:
 - (a) If the actual average is higher than submitted, the member is disqualified.
 - (b) If the actual average is lower than submitted, prize placing will be based on the average submitted.
5. The tournament will be handicapped – 100% of 240 base average.
6. The participation in SINGLES event is limited to one time. Participation in DOUBLES will be allowed as many times as the participant changes partners. The first score in DOUBLES will be used in all events.
7. The prize fund will be returned 100% on a ratio of 1 to 4 (1:4) entries; all events/handicap returned on a ratio of 1 out of 8 (1:8); and all events/scratch returned on a ratio of 1 out of 10 (1:10).
8. Errors in scoring must be reported to the tournament secretary within 24 hours.
9. Doubles will be bowled on one pair of lanes; singles will be bowled on another pair of lanes. Example: Doubles on lanes 1 and 2, singles on 3 and 4.
10. Doubles will be rolled first, singles will follow.
11. Entry fee shall be \$12.00 per person per event. Entry fees for optional all events/handicap is \$1.00 and optional all events/scratch is \$1.00.
12. Entries for both doubles and singles will be accepted up to one hour prior to each shift's start time, if lanes are available. Entry closing date will be the last date of the tournament – November 1.
13. Scheduled bowling times will be given on a first come, first paid basis.
14. You do not have to bowl singles to bowl doubles and vice versa.
15. Up to three (3) pair of doubles or six (6) singles may be assigned to a pair of lanes. PLEASE NOTE: This will be a 3-hour shift in most cases.
16. The Executive Board of the Iowa 600 Bowling Club shall decide any questions not covered by these rules.
