1. This tournament consists of three (3) separate events. The scores used for this tournament will be those rolled in the TEAM, DOUBLES and/or SINGLES (no exceptions) event of the Iowa State USBC WBA ("ISUSBCWBA") State Tournament. **(Scores for the team event are from the first time bowled if entered on multiple teams.)**
2. All participants must be members of the Iowa 600 Bowling Club, and their dues MUST be RECEIVED by the Iowa 600 Bowling Club office PRIOR to participation. **All participants must be current members of the ISUSBCWBA and USBC.** Only members of certified leagues or substitutes whose membership dues have been paid and in accordance with the USBC and ISUSBCWBA By-Laws may participate in this tournament.
3. The entry fee shall be \$6.00 PER EVENT (breakdown for each event - \$4.30 prize fund, 50¢ expense fund, 20¢ secretary compensation, and \$1.00 to be donated to the "Komen for the Cure®").
4. Handicap will be 100% of 240 base average.
5. Prize fund will be returned 100% on a basis of 1 to 4 entries for each event.
6. **Entry closing date is February 12, 2011** (one week prior to first day of Iowa State USBC WBA state tournament – February 19, 2011, continuing through May 15, 2011, unless extended). Entries are not refundable or transferable.
7. Bowlers may participate in each event ONLY once (*team event – first entry if bowling on multiple teams*).
8. Entering average: You will use the same average as the Iowa State USBC WBA State Tournament as in accordance with ISUSBCWBA State rules (on reverse side).
9. Rules 319a-2 (10-pin average), 319d (prize winnings provisions), and 319e (tournament average) are waived. Incorrect averages will be governed by Rule 319a-3. All other rules and regulations shall remain in effect. **DISCLAIMER: USBC language/rules will apply in all areas affected.**
10. Score sheets must be sent to the Iowa 600 Bowling Club office as soon as possible following competition. **All scores mailed must be postmarked no later than 10 days following the final day of the ISUSBCWBA State Tournament.** It is the bowler's responsibility to turn the scores in. Photocopies will be accepted. All corrections must be initialed by the scorekeeper or tournament official.
11. All conditions governing the ISUSBCWBA State Tournament will apply to this Iowa 600 State Tournament.

**General Information:** A score box will be provided at the Tournament Office in the bowling centers. Scores may be placed in the score box as they will be mailed to the Iowa 600 Club secretary periodically. Use of the score box is at the bowler's own risk. Otherwise, it is the bowler's responsibility to send her scores in the mail.

### AVERAGE QUALIFICATIONS

**ENTERING AVERAGE AND VERIFICATION:** All references to averages shall include the **highest average of not less than 21 games** that has been established in **any USBC** certified league and association in the following order:

- (a) Highest average in all leagues and associations of not less than 21 games in one league at the end of the 2009-2010 season.
- (b) Any member who did not have an established average the previous season shall use her highest average of not less than 21 games in one league including league play of November 30, 2010.\*
- (c) If no 21-game average as of November 30, 2010, the bowler will use her average as of January 31, 2011, of at least 21 games in one league.
- (d) If no 21-game average on either of the above, the bowler may bowl with an established average in any USBC league of at least 12 games as of the first date of tournament participation.\*
- (e) Summer league (2010) average as of at least 12 games will be used only if the member has no other established average. Summer league of 2009 will not be accepted.\*
- (f) If a bowler does not meet any of the previously listed average requirements, she may enter the tournament with a 250 average.

\*Must use highest average in **ANY USBC ASSOCIATION AND LEAGUES** of **not less than 21 games** (except d) in the above order.

A multiple member from another state association will be permitted to bowl in the state tournament, provided she meets the Iowa State USBC average requirement.
