

IOWA STATE USBC WBA 2011 STATE CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT CAPTAIN'S INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT: Please review this information and share with all team/doubles/singles entrants.

RULES: The rules were included on your original entry form and should have been retained by the captain. A copy is available on our website, iowawba.com.

CHECK-IN:

Team Event – Bridge City Bowl: Team captain must check in and present all five (5) USBC membership cards for the team **AT LEAST ONE HOUR PRIOR TO SCHEDULED SQUAD TIME**. After check in, the team will report to the ISUSBCWBA photographer for a team picture. PICTURES ARE REQUIRED, purchase is optional.

Doubles & Singles – Champion Bowl: Check in **ONE HOUR** prior to scheduled squad time. Partners should check in together. Present USBC card at time of check in.

PLEASE NOTE: FAILURE TO PRESENT USBC CARD WILL RESULT IN BOWLER BEING ASKED TO DONATE \$2.00 TO Bowlers to Veterans Link (BVL). Re-prints, copies, or league receipts will be accepted.

PHOTOS: Team photos are required, purchase is optional. There is **NOT** a photographer at the D/S center; however, doubles/singles pictures will be available at the team center. **IT IS ILLEGAL TO MAKE COPIES OF ANY PHOTOS TAKEN BY THE ISUSBCWBA PHOTOGRAPHER AS THEY ARE COPY-RIGHTED.**

SUBSTITUTES: Please make every effort to secure your own substitutes! If assistance is needed, contact the ISUSBCWBA office. There will be a limited number of substitutes available. Fax, email, or mail substitution forms/information to the state office as soon as possible prior to scheduled bowling date. **Last minute substitutions must be done at the tournament office at least 90 minutes prior to scheduled bowling time.**

DIVISIONS: If the average of a substitute changes the classification of an entry in any event, the entry will be re-classified accordingly.

AWARDS: 199 & 200 award pins will be awarded “on the spot”.

COMPLAINTS: All complaints regarding the tournament operation must be brought to the attention of the Tournament Official in charge. Any complaint regarding errors in scoring should be reported to the tournament office at each center or to the ISUSBCWBA office in Fort Dodge within 48 hours after bowling is completed. Tournament management has the authority to make decisions regarding anything not covered in the state tournament rules.

DISQUALIFICATION: Any unruly or inappropriate behavior from the use of alcohol or from any other cause will be grounds for immediate disqualification from the tournament.

CHILDREN: Children should be supervised by a non-bowling adult. Disruptive behavior by uncontrolled children shall be subject to the appropriate actions by house personnel or tournament management.

NON-SMOKING EVENT: The ISUSBCWBA State Tournament is a **NON-SMOKING** event. Smoking is NOT allowed from the time the squad starts until the bowler has finished her event. There is no smoking between games, between doubles & singles or at any time during the scheduled squad. **ABUSE OF THE RULES SUBJECTS THE BOWLER TO DISQUALIFICATION FROM THE TOURNAMENT.**
